China Organizational Name Administrastion Center



China's State Council Office for Public Sector Reform's CONAC (China Organizational Names Administration Centre) relied heavily on Allegravita to develop and execute a landmark deal in which 20,000 Chinesescript domain names of strategic importance were reserved for Chinese government use.

China's State Council, the national government's paramount governing body, utilizes the State Council Office for Public Sector Reform (SCOPSR) to manage all payments flowing down to all sections of China's bureaucracy. A key unit of SCOPSR is the China Organizational Names Administration Centre (CONAC), which is responsible for managing thenaming all key infrastructure in China.

A Finnish company had won the rights to two new Chinese-script top-level internet domains which, in English, mean ".online" and ".chinese-website". In 2014, it was very important to China's government to ensure that the domain names for all key geographical entities were controlled by CONAC, however no law existed for the government to have the rights to these key domains.

OUR PLAN:


Allegravita played the central role to help CONAC to identify the 10,000 most strategically important geographical names. The domains include the names of every city in China with populations of over 200,000 people, all 3,000 counties, all provinces, all municipalities, all Special Administrative Regions, and a number of key locations such as mountains, and combinations of industries+geography. This research and development project required approximately two months of careful work by our expert team.

IMPLEMENTATION:

Following identification of the names, Allegravita led the negotiation for acquisition of the domains. This project, led by Allegravita China director Raymond Li and CEO Simon Cousins, required many late nights in detailed discussions between CONAC and the Finnish company. A very satisfactory outcome was achieved, with China's government making the acquisition at a deeply discounted cost, with very favourable commercial terms.


RESULTS:
